MPB (3,2a) 1 Kettle's Lujesa Jean Genie, I thought her quite special, beautiful head, lovely eye & expression with finish of muzzle. A compact bitch with freedom of movement, has forechest, very sound on handling, most pleasing all through. RBP.

PD (4,3) 1 Buck's Clavaire Diamond Geeza, scored with his excellent balance throughout, which shows in his very true action, lovely clean front assembly, well set hocks, held his shape, clean length of neck, flowing topline, well rounded quarters, stands on sound bone with a tight compact foot, a well worked head with a kind eye completed the picture. Went on to BD, BP.

PB (3,1) 1 Beswick's Cachel Sunkissed, very good bone & feet, has forechest & spring of rib, firm in back & rear quarters, was steady on the move; 2 Thomas' Claramand Shadow Dancer, a lighter made bitch, well presented. Needs to body up, was steady in action.

JD 1 Thomas' Claramand Ziggy Ziggy, now this chap moved well in profile but tended to pull side ways coming towards which threw out his forehand, on handling he is sound, has a kind & balanced head, well bodied up, rounded with width in quarters & a well set tail.

JB (4,2) 1 Kettle's Lujesa Wishing On A Star, well put down, in condition, moved on a very good stride, with correct tail carriage, carries a good length of neck, clean lay of shoulder, she is well ribbed up, ample substance in rear quarters, on the stack gives a compact shape, careful not to place her quarters too far back. A sound bitch. RBB; 2 Buck's Clavaire Doodlebug, a lighter made bitch of 14 months, very feminine, needs to mature on & be more positive in action.

YB (4,1) 1 Corcoran's Troverothway Maisie May, stands well, firm slightly sloping topline, lovely bone & feet, ample spring of rib with length to firm loin, well angulated quarters with width of thigh, pleased in action with good tail carriage; 2 Hutson's Stobytill Shake Ya Booty, not as mature as May, she moved with a positive action all ways. Lashing tail, topline held, just needs to body up.

M (3,1) 1 Pitt's Wagaflag Magical Mayhem, I liked this bitch in head, very kind eye, may be a tad long cast but handles well, carries a good spring of rib, free side gait, again she just requires maturity; 2 Hughes' Sharemead Simone, a very merry & feminine bitch who moved true, she just lacked substance throughout, but she showed to best advantage & gives pleasure.

N (3) 1 L Wishing On A Star; 2 W Magical Mayhem; 3 S Simone.

PGD (5) 1 Worgan's Lujesa License To Thrill for Luthame, excellent presentation, handles well on the table giving a lovely balanced profile, kind dark eye, good finish of muzzle, firm backline, well rounded quarters with low set hocks. Sound & true action. Took RBD; 2 Garrard's Clavaire Silver Doller, balanced angles, has forechest & a good

spring of rib, tail well set, ideally would prefer more length to neck, he moved on a good stride; 3 Cassidy's Manchela Hugo Boss.

PGB (4,1) 1 Taylor's Molkara Purple Prose at Triveka, shown to advantage, in condition, not overdone, very true & positive on the move, kept her balanced frame at all times, lovely free flowing action, a compact bitch with a most pleasing head & expression, very sound on handling. Pleased to award her BIS; 2 Corcoran's Troverothway Just A Star, looks good on the stack, short & firm in back, kind dark eye, low set ear, was steady on the move; 3 Reed's Reemif Seventh Heaven.

LD 1 Emlimajo Against All Odds, up to size, carries a big spring of rib, has width in rear quarters with a good bend of stifle.

LB 1 Hutson's Stobytill Eliza Dolittle, lovely profile action, tail held correctly, elbows kept close to body, I liked her feminine & balanced head, she is well bodied with length of rib, in excellent muscletone, very kindly expression.

OD (3,1) 1 Cox's Gardenstone Pale Rider to Suvern, a male of substance who strode out to best advantage, well ribbed up to strength of loin, good width & substance in quarters, clean arched neck flows neatly to level backline, stands on sound straight bone; 2 Worgan's Luthame Mr Bond, good side gait. A little loose coming towards, kept a firm gentle sloping topline, sound on handling.

OB (4) 1 Hutson's Carmelfair Tarrarrah at Stobytill, moved to please, lovely tail action, very sound & positive action all ways, very kind gentle expression, gives a pleasing picture all through, sound on handling. Went on to BV; 2 Reed's Reemif Ice Ice Baby, carries good sound bone, ample spring of rib, has width of thigh, steady on the move; 3 W Magical Mayhem.

B (8,4) 1 Covington's Rojoy's Chase The Dream, won on her very positive movement, lovely outline with slight arch to neck, excellent bone with tight feet, liked her rounded quarters with low set hocks used to drive her along; 2 Taylor's Triveka Melody Pond, stands over her ground well, liked her balanced outline, kind dark eye, well bodied up, sound rear quarters, very clean rear action; 3 M Hugo Boss.

V(6,2) 1 Covington's Molkara Crystal Rose with Silverdust, shown to advantage, very pleasing outline, with length of neck, clean over her shoulders, level backline, lovely kind eye & expression, moved out on a very sound & true stride; 2 Lockwood's Lujesa Casellina at Chimewood, again well presented & moved with a good action, has depth of body, firm backline, rounded quarters & low set hocks, pleased in head & eye; 3 Reed's Reemif Blue Reflection.
